HIGHLIGHTS

BYLAW AND POLICY:

Bylaw No. 10-2019: Council passed first reading of Bylaw No. 10-2019 being a bylaw to amend Bylaw No. 2-2018 the Land Use Bylaw to remove Cemeteries from the list of Discretionary Uses in Urban General (UG) District zoning. Council will hold a Public Hearing at the October 23, 2019 Council Meeting. Please visit the County website for further Public Hearing details.

COMMUNITY CONNECTIONS:

Urban ICF's: As per provincial legislation, the County of Two Hills is collaborating with the Town of Two Hills and the Village of Myrnam to generate Intermunicipal Collaboration Frameworks (ICFs). Council requests quotes be obtained prior to engaging consultants to meet the approaching April 2020 deadline.

Delegation: Mr. Tony Hewko and Mr. Dakota House, previously of North of 60, presenting a plan regarding the redevelopment of the Mary Immaculate Hospital and Dormitory in Willingdon. The site will see a new life as the Willingdon Training Centre, contracted with the Dakota House Foundation™, which will draw in people from across the country. Going M.I.L.E.S.® (Motivate, Inspire, Lead, Empower, and Succeed) is a pragmatic youth and community empowerment program which assists participants with a new train of thought and positive lifestyle.

Two Hills Airport: Council will support the Two Hills Town and County Airport Commission in their grant application to the Community Airport Program for new runway lighting infrastructure, sharing half of the required twenty-five (25) percent of municipal contribution with the Town of Two Hills, funding approximately \$43,750.00.

Unsightly Properties & Un-permitted Development: Council has expressed concern with unsightly properties and un-permitted developments in the County hamlets. Bylaw enforcement fines will be issued for non-compliance.

TAX PAYMENT DEADLINE

The last day for payment of the 2019 Property Taxes is **October 31, 2019**. After that date, all outstanding 2019 Property Taxes will be subject to a 10% penalty, which will be applied November 1, 2019. Tax payment must be received at Municipal Office on or prior to October 31, 2019.

2019 GRAVEL SALES ENDING

The deadline for 2019 gravel orders will be **October 7, 2019.** The County will receive new gravel orders for next season onward of April 1, 2020. Gravel delivery agreements must be signed and payment made prior to orders being delivered. 2020 deliveries will commence once the Seasonal Road Bans are removed.
