 - Leak Detection Waiting for Leak Detection Report from "Tangle Ridge" for the aluminum and steel lines.
 - Tap 10 to 20 Loop TransCanada Pipeline (TCP) has confirmed a reconnection. Plans still in progress for a November 2015 completion date.
 - New Tap 60 Feed TransCanada Pipeline (TCP) confirmed a re-connection at no cost.
 - Cathodic Protection: Some repairs being done in Myrnam. Corpro slated for July 2015.
- D. Dyck informed the Committee that the Truck Tool Kits have been assembled, except the spare truck to date.
- D. Wilson informed the Committee that the Heater Repair Replacement Plan is in progress.
- D. Wilson informed the Committee that Rife Resources is requesting a line reroute quote from the Natural Gas Utility, with the possibility of new infill.
- D. Dyck informed the Committee that the Federation of Alberta Gas Co-ops is implementing "Geographical Information System" for mapping of gas lines, Administration investigating the said system.
