Gravel Agreements

Gravel Sale At the February 11, 2014 Council Meeting the County of Minburn requested to purchase 50,000 cubic yards of crushed ³/₄" gravel as per County specifications at \$12.80 per cubic yard, plus GST, from the County of Two Hills with storage for several years.

The County of Two Hills requested that the County of Minburn provide the County of Two Hills with their detailed specifications prior to entering into an agreement for the purchase of gravel.

R. Bouchard informed the Committee that the County of Minburn's detailed specifications were received.
