## Shop

- Inspections on heavy trucks ongoing
- Installed new lighting in Two Hills main shop, Willingdon shop and Myrnam shop
- Wiring issues found in Main Shop outside plugs; 14 gauge wire and 15 amp breakers not sufficient, replacing with 12 gauge wire and 20 amp breakers

## Maintenance

- Graders scarifying local roads due to slippery conditions
- Fire wood commenced; delayed due to cold weather
- Mulching of RR 113 north of Hwy 45 4 miles complete, continuing in the area; churches to be done in the next month
- General repairs ongoing and inventory near completion

#### Crusher

- Installation of new liner complete
- Rocky Mountain Equipment did a complete inspection of the cone bushings are in excellent condition, some maintenance will be required in 6 months
- Crusher start-up of January 7<sup>th</sup> delayed due to cold weather; start-up now expected on January 12<sup>th</sup> (weather permitting)
- Investigating renting a pre-jaw surge bin for the crusher and a gravel screener
