Policy

Driveways serving fulltime residents may be gravelled (not more than every four years) at no cost to the landowner/renter, maximum gravel applied and spread will be ten cubic yards. This gravelling and spreading will only be performed when the County is gravelling roads in the area (as addressed in the County's approved four year Road Gravelling Rotation Program).

The County, for safety reasons, reserves the right not to apply gravel on driveways serving fulltime residents due to conditions that exist in the obstruction of gravel application as identified by the gravel hauler (i.e. low overhead power lines, trees, etc.). Hamlets and lakes are not eligible.
